Dear Parents and Guardians,

This year, the Education Department has introduced a revision to the Victorian Teaching and Learning Model (VTLM 2.0). The Victorian Teaching and Learning Model 2.0 is based on the most recent evidence and school-based practice.

The department developed the VTLM 2.0 in consultation with the Australian Education Research Organisation (AERO). It is also informed by insights from school leaders and practitioners, and effective teaching and learning practices already in place in many schools across Victoria. All Victorian government schools are working to embed the VTLM 2.0 in their teaching and learning programs from the start of the 2028 school year.

The VTLM 2.0 introduces an emphasis on the evidence about how students learn as the basis for effective teaching. It provides increased clarity for teachers about the elements of teaching that have the strongest evidence base. The VTLM 2.0 links to best practice approaches from existing departmental frameworks that contribute to effective student wellbeing and classroom management.

This will be one of the main foci for professional learning at Templestowe Valley this year and we are looking forward to learning all about how the model works in classrooms.
